Riesling Grand Cru Schoenenbourg 2021

It is the terroir that takes pride of place in the bouquet of this Schoenenbourg. It reveals mineral, minty and fruity nuances. The wine has a little fatness, finesse and width. Riesling Grand Cru Wineck-Schlossberg 2021


